

Important information:

Fitness requirements:

You should be confident that you can walk your chosen distance. The route has a number of stiles and gateways plus some rough ground to negotiate.

Medical back up:

The course marshals will be able to help by calling in medical assistance in the unlikely event of an emergency.

Restrictions:

Walkers under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

Dogs to be kept under strict control and on a short lead at all times.

Distribution of sponsorship donations:

If you use the **Rotary Club of Romsey Test JustGiving** walk page, we will send 80% to the charity of your choice. If not, we will send 75%. But in either case, the balance will all go to the Rotary Club of Romsey Test supported charities. You may choose to donate 100% to Rotary supported charities.

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
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

Walk the TEST WAY

For the Charity of your choice

Walk The Test Way is one of the leading Charity Walks in this part of the country. Originally established in 2003 it is held annually towards the end of the year. This year's Walk is being held on 27 September 2020.

Walk The Test Way enables individuals, companies and other organisations with employees to raise funds for a Charity of your choice. Each year over 600 walkers take part and enjoy raising funds for charity, with nearly £1m raised to date!

Choose your distance

You can choose the distance you and your colleagues wish to walk. There are five start points along the beautiful Test Way, ranging from 5 miles (8k) to 25.5 miles (41k). This means everyone in your team can take part, regardless of fitness levels.

Walk The Test Way is an ideal event for companies and other organisations with employees to take part in and can be very rewarding and motivating for everyone involved. This helps with Corporate Social Responsibility as well as building great team spirit. Here are some examples:

Check In is at the Crosfield Hall in Romsey. Coaches take you to the start point you have chosen. The route takes you back to the attractive market town of Romsey along the Test Way, finishing in the War Memorial Park.
